Return to School August 2020

We are very much looking forward to welcoming back all pupils and families, with a particularly warm welcome to all our new Primary 1 pupils. We are aware that school will look and feel different for us all, but as always, our priority will be to support the health and wellbeing of all pupils, parents/ carers and staff.

In line with the advice above and letter of 3 August from Tony McDaid, Executive Director Education Resources, South Lanarkshire Council, I write to advise you of our plans for a managed return as per below:

Nursery:

Information was posted all to parents/carers at the end of June advising of arrangements for the managed return/start dates of all Nursery class pupils. These arrangements are still in place and Nursery pupils should attend at the dates/times specified on your individual letters.







A Parent Information Sheet which outlines some key information to support the safe return of all pupils will be shared on our school parent app, and the website in the next few days which will detail relevant information you may find helpful, including staggered entry/exit arrangements, what to bring to school, lunch arrangements etc. Previously issued advice regarding school uniform and the school car park has not changed. **General advice**

All children will be required to wash or sanitise their hands on entry to the school building and to classes.

There remains the need for 2m social distancing around the school perimeter at all times for parents/carers and any other visiting adults. Where this is difficult, our advice would be to wear a face covering where possible.

We are required to keep the number of visitors to the school to a minimum, in accordance with national guidance. Any contact with the school should be made by telephone or email to the office in the first instance.
